
Frame, Wire, Label

Framing

- 2D artists will need to frame & wire artwork. Stretched canvas artwork requires wiring only.
- 3D artwork will need to provide supportive material or stands for display, if applicable.
- All entries when delivered must arrive ready to hang or display.

Wiring Your Artwork


All artwork needs to be framed, wired and ready to hang /display. If works are on canvas, no frame is necessary, but still need to be wired. Wires should be installed no more than a third of the way down on the artwork and *when wire is pulled taut, it sits at least 3 inches below the top of the frame*.



Types of wiring that will not be accepted



For store bought wood frames, eye hooks or d-hooks need to be screwed into frame and wired.



Acceptable metal frames have a track to accommodate hangers.



Labeling Your Artwork

The back of each piece of artwork should be labeled with: first & last name, and title of artwork (please print.) The label must be either taped on or written on the back of the artwork.
